All instructors are experienced, seasoned fly fishers who have fished across the country and abroad. The course is being

held September 19, 2009, at the **Devil's Backbone County Park on Antietam Creek** in Washington County near **Boonsboro, MD**, and is limited to 40 students. *The minimum age is 14 years.* Plan to join us for a fun-filled day of learning to fly fish.

What is FFF-MAC?



The **Federation of Fly Fishers Mid-Atlantic Council (FFF-MAC)** is one of 13 regional councils of the **Federation of Fly Fishers**, a national non-profit organization devoted to fisheries conservation and fly fishing education which is headquartered in Bozeman, Montana. **FFF-MAC** has a membership of more than 850 individuals and two dozen local fly fishing clubs located in Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia and the District of Columbia.

Each year **FFF-MAC** provides conservation grant money to member clubs sponsoring stream improvement or conservation education programs. A **Youth Camp** for aspiring fly fishers has been held for several years at sites throughout the region. These outreach efforts provide unique opportunities for **FFF-MAC** members to meet other fly fishers and to gain a perspective on fisheries issues in our region and across the U.S. FFF members receive the quarterly **Mid-Atlantic Flyfisher** to keep abreast of these activities.

FFF-MAC affiliated and charter clubs are the backbone of the Council. Each of these clubs meet on a regular basis with speakers and frequent instruction in fly tying, fly casting and fly fishing techniques. Many beginning fly fishers learn the sport and improve their skills by joining these local clubs and participating in their activities. Many clubs schedule fishing outings and trips. Additionally, members have an opportunity to participate in conservation and stream improvement projects or teach children and adults about fly fishing and water resources protection.

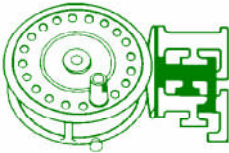
